Alan G. Frazier, Sr., age 85, of Dixon, formerly of Saugatuck MI and Richton Park, IL, died Tuesday, July 5, 2016 at Heritage Square, surrounded by family. He was born November 9, 1930, in Hartford, Connecticut, the son of Robert and Martha (Roda) Frazier.

Alan, known as Al, served his country in the Air National Guard of the United States and the Air National Guard of Connecticut from 1950 to 1953. He worked for Aetna Life Insurance in Hartford, Conn., then for CNA (Continental National Assurance) in Chicago, IL for 35 years as a national accounts executive. During his lifetime, he always would serve on committees, local town government organizations, and church boards. He believed it was important to be active in the community and give one's volunteer service whenever possible. He attended Episcopal churches for his spiritual nurturing during his lifetime. Al was a loyal Boston Red Sox baseball fan, and always cheered for UConn basketball teams as well as Michigan State football. He married Lois C. Wilson on November 17, 1951, in Hartford, Connecticut. She preceded him in death on December 27, 2007.

Al is survived by his two daughters Cheryl (Rory) Sohn of Dixon, IL, Beverly Brouillard of Omaha, NE, and one son Alan G. (Marsha) Frazier, Jr. of Lowell, IN. He has six grandchildren, Brittani and Gabriel Sohn of Dixon, Rachelle Brouillard of Lincoln, NE, and Alan, Christina, Thomas Frazier of Lowell, IN. He also has several great grandchildren. His surviving brother is Bob Frazier of West Palm Beach, FL.

He was preceded in death by his wife, his parents and a brother, Jack Frazier. Cremation rites have been accorded. A celebration of life service will be held, Thursday, August 11, 2016 at 10 am at Heritage Square followed by sweet refreshments.
