Alberta 'Bert' G. Devenny, age 93 of Dixon, died Tuesday Nov. 22, 2022 at Dixon Health Care and Rehabilitation Center. She was born Dec. 16, 1928 in Chicago the daughter of Albert and Rose (White) Klein. Alberta had worked at Woods Equipment in Oregon for several years. She was a member of St Patrick Catholic Church, the Red Hats and had volunteered with Meals on Wheels.

When Bert was a young woman, she worked in an office. She saw Francis 'Frank' Devenny and bet a co-worker that she could get him to ask her out. She married Frank Aug. 27, 1949 in Chicago. He preceded her in death April 4, 1990. She was also preceded in death by one brother Al and three sisters Helen, Marge and Dorothy "Sis".

Bert and Frank started life together in Chicago, IL (where she loved going to Lincoln Park Zoo), they lived in Cary, IL for several years (where she loved to ice skate on the Fox River), went back to Chicago, then moved to Colorado for a few years after which they moved back to Chicago and then settled in Dixon, living in Lost Nation for many years and Bert relocated into town 15 years ago.

Bert is survived by her children Scott (Mary) Devenny of Blue River, WI, Mark (Marianne) Devenny of Woodstock, IL, Shawn Devenny of Schaumburg, IL, 7 grandchildren -Michael, Jean (Ray), Stephanie (Joshua), Cheryl (Edgar), Keith, Shannon, Rianne, and 3 great grandchildren – Ainsley, Isaac, and Peyton.

After family and friends, her greatest joy was shopping sales. She knew every sales rack in Dixon as well as Pennys & other stores that were in the mall in Sterling.
