November 26, 1919 - December 9, 2016

Alice R. Finn, age 97, of Dixon, died Friday, December 9, 2016, in her home. She was born in Amboy, November 26, 1919, the daughter of Frank and Fannie (Mule) Merlo.

She was a Secretary for USF&G in Dixon, and then a Legal Secretary for the Winnebago County States Attorney's Office.
