August 14, 1918 - June 1, 2017

Alice Marie White, 98, passed away on Thursday, June 1, 2017 in Decatur, IL where she had been residing near family. She was born on August 14, 1918 in Dixon to Ross and Alice Cooper. Alice was married on August 2, 1941 to Weldon "Red" White at St. Patrick's Church in Dixon. They were married for 66 years until Red's death on April 15, 2008.

Alice held many jobs during her lifetime. She had been a bank teller, was a secretary to the superintendent of two Reynolds Wire Company plants in the early 1940s, was the bookkeeper for Red White Ornamental Iron Works from 1946-1969, and then went to work at Sauk Valley College as the Reproduction Room Supervisor until her retirement in 1976. She was a very loving mother and grandmother to her family.

Survivors include sons: Michael (Joanne) White of Ferryville, Wisconsin; Patrick (Chris) White of Decatur; and daughter: Karen (Bill) Mancini, of Fort Collins, Colorado; six grandchildren; seven great grandchildren; and her sister, Patricia Flanagan, Tucson, Arizona.

In addition to her husband, Alice was preceded in death by her parents, a sister, Margaret Ortgiesen, and a brother, Edward Cooper.
