Antoine L. "Buck" Clairmont, age 87, of Amboy, died Wednesday, November 21, 2018, peacefully at home surrounded by his family. He was born January 19, 1931, in Forsyth Twp., Michigan, the son of Joseph and Bertha (Frazer) Clairmont.
