



## Avis Natalin Keho

January 25, 1929 - September 15, 2017

Avis Natalin Keho, age 88, of Rockford, and formerly of Amboy, died Friday, September 15, 2017, at Crimson Pointe Assisted Living Center in Rockford. She was born January 25, 1929, in Sublette, the daughter of Samuel and Edna (Bates) Goode. Natalin worked as a Secretary for Attorney Edward Sullivan in Amboy as well as for the Amboy CUSD #272 for many years prior to her retirement.

She was a member of St. Patrick Catholic Church in Amboy.
