Benjamin "Ben" Miliano age 88 of Dixon, IL died Sunday Feb. 10, 2008 in his home. He was born Feb. 19, 1919 in Manhattan New York City, NY the son of Joseph and Rosa (Massari) Miliano. He had been employed as a photoengraver in the New York, New Jersey and Chicago areas prior to his retirement
