



## Bernadine Robbins

June 13, 1933 - October 5, 2009

Bernadine J. "Sis" Robbins, age 76 of Sterling, and formerly of Amboy, died Monday October 5, 2009 in her home. She was born in Noble, Illinois June 13, 1933 the daughter of Richard Berlin and Leora (Shatto) Worrell. She had been a bookkeeper for W.G. Leffelman and Sons in Amboy for 20 years.
