Betty J. Kidd, age 93, of Amboy, died Monday, August 13, 2018, at Maple Crossing in Amboy. She was born July 15, 1925, in Amboy, the daughter of Paul and Lena (Heckman) Wasson.

Betty had worked at the Green River Ordnance Plant and the Midwest Rug Factory in Amboy, as well as JC Penney and Montgomery Ward's in Dixon. She also helped her husband with the family farm.

She was a member of the United First Church in Amboy, and the church's Women's Club the Friendly Faithful Fellowship.

Betty married William R. Kidd at the United Methodist Church in Amboy March 22, 1952. He preceded her in death September 10, 2010. She was also preceded in death by her daughter Debbie Lynn Kidd; 2 brothers Edwin and Vernon Wasson.
