



## Burnham Grossman

June 11, 1912 - March 5, 2012

Burnham Grossman age 99 of Amboy died Monday March 5, 2012 at Amboy Rehabilitation and Nursing Center. He was born June 11, 1912 the son of Gustaf and Lena (Hoffman) Grossman. He was a life long farmer and a school bus driver. Burnham lived in the same residence for 62 years. He was a member of the Immanuel Lutheran Church in Amboy, and a life time member of the Lee County Farm Bureau. He was united in marriage to Ethel A. Larson in Peoria, Illinois November 12, 1942.
