Carol Ann Holland, age 73, of Dixon, passed away on December 22, 2015, after a brief two-month battle with cancer, surrounded by family at Rush University Medical Center.

Carol was born in 1942, the daughter of Russell and Lorraine (Ruble) Hinshaw, in Eureka, IL. Carol was employed at Dixon Public Schools as a kindergarten teacher until her retirement in 2001. Carol was an active member of the First United Methodist Church in Dixon, participating on various committees, choir and playing in the bell choir. She enjoyed traveling and spending time with family and friends at their Wisconsin home on Little Silver Lake. She was an avid gardener.

Carol was preceded in death by her father and mother.
