Charles W. Clinker, age 83 of Dixon, died Monday June 16, 2008 at KSB Hospital. He was born in Dixon January 23, 1925 the son of Bert and Pauline (Hass) Clinker. He was the head storekeeper at both the Dixon Developmental Center and the Dixon Correctional Center prior to his retirement in 1987. He was a member of St. Anne Catholic Church in Dixon. He was a Flight Officer in the US Army Air Corps from 1943-1945 assigned to B29 Bombers as a radar bombardier in the South Pacific Theater. He was Past Commander of the Dixon American Legion Post 12, Past Chef De Gare of the Lee County Voiture #409 40&8. He was also a member of the Dixon Elks Lodge #779 and the Dixon Moose Lodge.
