Charles F Doyle age 87 of Rockford died Aug. 21, 2006 in his home. He was born Feb. 15, 2006 in Dixon, IL the son of John and Mary (Clark) Doyle. He attended St. Mary Grade School in Dixon and Dixon High School. He was a veteran of the US Marine Corps during WW II serving 38 months at Pearl Harbor as an M.P. He married Helen O'Malley Oct. 9, 1944 at St. Mary Catholic Church in Sterling. He was employed as a Dispatch Operator for Illinois Northern Utilities/Public Service/Commonwealth Edison from 1935 until retiring in 1986. He served as president of IBEW Local 1557 from 1956 to 1960. He was a member of Knights of Columbus Council 690 in Dixon. He was a member of the Board of Directors of St. Michael Cemtery Maytown,IL He was a past member of St. Patrick Catholic Church in Dixon where he sang in the adult choir and served as an usher. He has been a member of Holy Family Parish Rockford from 1972 to the present. He is survived by his wife of Rockford, 2 daughters Maureen Nichols of Dixon, Mary (Michael Scheurich) Doyle of Rockford, IL, a son Terry (Sally) Doyle of Sussex, WI, 2 grandsons, 3 granddaughters, and 4 great grandchildren. He was preceded in death by 3 brothers James, William and Jack Doyle, 2 sisters Frances Doyle Rink and Dorothy Doyle McGrath. A mass of Christian Burial will be on Friday Aug. 25, 2006 at 11:00 AM at Holy Family Catholic Church in Rockford with the Msgr. Thomas Bales pastor and Fr Pierre Polycarp Chaplain co-officiating.
