Charles L. "Happy Charlie" Pitzer, age 75 of Amboy, died Friday April 2, 2010 in his home. He was born in Dixon, Illinois September 20, 1934 the son of George and Emma (Ankney) Pitzer Sr.. He had been a farmer, and had also worked at Allied Locke Industries, Crop Mate, and Amboy Specialty Foods. He was a member of the United First Church, the Prairie Repose Cemetery Board, the Amboy Township Board, and a founding member of Bonanza Creek Farms and Shooting Preserve.
