Charles G. Scudder, age 87, of Dixon, died Thursday December 8, 2011 at Dixon Healthcare Center. He was born October 1, 1924 in Dixon, the son of Vernis and Leapha Pearl (Groharing) Scudder. He worked as a breadman for Beiers and then Butternut Bread for many years prior to his retirement. Charles was a veteran of the US Army during World War II.
