Conan B. "Connie" Cox age 68 of Dixon died Friday July 2, 2010 following a long illness at the Veterans Administration Rehabilitation Center in Des Moines, IA. He was born Sept. 5, 1941 in Dixon, IL the son of Roscoe and Mary Sue (Stewart) Cox. He had been a Deputy Sheriff with the Lee County Sheriffs Dept. for over 25 years prior to his retirement. He was a Veteran of the Marine Corps serving as a MP and was a member of the Marine Corps Boxing Team. He was a member of the FOP and the Masons. He married Marie Powell June 15, 1981 in Las Vegas, NV. He was preceded in death by his father and a sister Sharon. He is survived by his wife of Dixon, stepchildren Jerome Costliow of Dixon, Jonathan (Colleen) Costliow of DeKalb, Theresa (Greg) Selgestad of Dixon, Elizabeth (Mike) Sutherland of Florida, Angela Aurand of Dixon, 11 grandchildren, 4 great grandchildren, his mother of Dixon, and a brother Roscoe Cox Jr. of Dixon.
