On Sunday, August 26, 2007, David "Dave" Boyle of Nachusa lost his brave and fearless fight with colon cancer surrounded by his family. He was born February 14, 1952 the son of Robert and Eileen (Long) Boyle of Amboy. On July 15, 1972 he married his wife Deborah (Parke) Boyle at the First Baptist Church in Dixon. They were married 35 years this past July.

Dave was employed at Harden's Auto and Truck Repair in Dixon for over 22 years. He was a member of St. Patrick Catholic Church in Amboy and was a past volunteer for the Nachusa Fire Department. He was a proud United States Army Veteran serving from 1972-1974.
