Dean W Shippert age 89 of Dixon died Sunday Aug. 16, 2015 at OSF St Anthony Medical Center in Rockford. He was born Sept. 4, 1925 in a farm house in rural Nachusa, IL the son of Edward and Sadie (Welch) Shippert. He had worked for Allied Van Lines for 60 years.

He was a graduate of Franklin Grove High School.

Dean was a Seaman First Class in the United States Coast Guard receiving an Honorable Discharge in 1947.

He married Iris Margene O'Rorke in Baltimore, MD in 1945. She preceded him in death April 19, 2012. They enjoyed wintering in Arizona.

Dean is survived by 6 sons, Mike (Sue) Shippert of Dixon, John Patrick Shippert of Freeport, Frank Shippert of Dixon, Tom (Micki) Shippert of Dixon, Jim (Mary) Shippert of Dixon, Jeff Shippert of Dixon, 26 grandchildren, 37 great grandchildren and 2 great great grandchildren.

He was also preceded in death by 2 brothers Edward and Glen Shippert.
