



## Dennis Paul Ackert

January 19, 1949 - April 7, 2015

Dennis P. Ackert, age 66, of Walton, died Tuesday, April 7, 2015, at KSB Hospital in Dixon. He was born January 19, 1949, in Dixon, the son of Edward F. and Ruth M. "Sally" (Oester) Ackert. Dennis attended Walton Grade School and graduated from Newman Central Catholic High School in Sterling in 1967. He was a life long farmer in the Walton area, and had also worked at Henry Pratt Co. in Dixon for 39 years prior to his retirement. Dennis was a devoted husband and loved his children, grandchildren, family and friends more than life.

Dennis was a Veteran of the Army during the Vietnam War.

He was a member of St. Mary's Catholic Church in Walton, and the Dixon American Legion. He had also been Marion Township Trustee for many years. Dennis married Bonnie Bingham in Dixon June 26, 1971.

He was preceded in death by his father.
