



Deryle Alfred Nickel

October 3, 1979 - May 24, 2014

Deryle A. "D.J." Nickel, age 34. of Amboy, died Saturday May 24, 2014, at Mendota Community Hospital as a result of injuries sustained in a motorcycle accident.

He was born October 3, 1979, in Monroe, WI, the son of Deryle and Judy (Delhotal) Nickel.

He had worked for D&L Concrete, then the West Brooklyn Co-op. He had currently been employed with the Local 150 as a Heavy Equipment Operator for 13 years.

D.J. was a member of Pheasants Forever.

He married Beth Burkart in Sublette October 11, 2003.

He was preceded in death by his maternal grandfather Donald Delhotal; paternal grandparents Alfred and Alyce Nickel.

Survivors include his Wife; 3 children Calvin, Kenzie, and Baylie all at home; his parents of Amboy; 1 sister Francine (Scott) Sichta of Joliet; 1 brother Hank (Genia) Nickel of Mendota; his maternal grandmother Margaret Delhotal of Dixon; also many aunts, uncles, and cousins.
