June 19, 1918 - December 23, 2006

Donald M. Bonnell, age 88 of Dixon died at his home Saturday December 23 2006. He was born in Sublette, Illinois June 19, 1918 the son of Cecil and Elizabeth (Moir) Bonnell. He worked as a pressman for the Wayside Press in Mendota for 18 years. He also farmed in the Franklin Grove area and was a truck driver for Ruan Transport Co. for 5 years prior to his retirement. He was a Veteran of the US Army from July 1940 to June 1945 with the 3rd Infantry Division in the African and European Theaters. He was a life member of the D.A.V., and a life member of the Dixon VFW Post #540. He was united in marriage to Evelyn Myers in Mendota, Illinois March 21, 1949. He was preceded in death by his parents, brothers Harold and Leo Bonnell and sisters Marjorie Alshouse, Mildred Wittenauer and Marion McBride. He is survived by his wife of Dixon; brother Harvey (Jean) Bonnell of Slidell, LA; sisters Grace Alshouse of Stoughton, WI and Ruth (George) Draege of Oregon; several nieces and nephews. Funeral services will be on Wednesday Dec. 27, 2006 at 2:00 PM in the Mihm-Jones Funeral Home in Amboy with the Rev. Judith Sherk officiating. Burial will follow at Woodside Cemetery in Lee Center with military honors by the Dixon Combined Veterans Group.
