Donald W. Glenn, age 78, of Sublette, died Sunday Dec. 18, 2016 at OSF St Anthony Medical Center in Rockford, following a short illness. He was born June 10, 1938 in Amboy, the son of Ralph and Charlotte (Long) Glenn. He worked as a carpenter and did construction work before working at Henry Pratt Co. in Dixon for 39 years prior to his retirement.

Don was a Veteran of the Army, a member of the Mendota VFW Post 6690, the NRA, and was an avid NASCAR fan. He was a quiet man who loved his family with all his heart.
