Dorothy J. Jeanblanc, age 87, of Polo, died Sunday, July 24, 2016, peacefully in her home. She was born in Amboy on June 26, 1929, the daughter of Floyd and Marjorie (Clayton) Noble.

Dorothy had worked at various locations throughout her life including Secretary for Lee Center Community School District #271 and Sauk Valley College; later in her life she became a Real Estate Broker.

She was a founding member and President of the Lee County Genealogical Society and also former President of the State of Illinois Genealogical Society. She attended church at the Lee Center Congregational United Church of Christ and also United First Church in Amboy.

Dorothy married Ernest A. Jeanblanc in Polo, on December 28, 1946.
