Edward (Eddie) R. Cooper age 95 of Dixon died Sunday May 20, 2012 at Jennings Terrace in Aurora. He was born Oct. 27, 1916 in Ogle County, Illinois the son of Ross and Alice (Tully) Cooper. He had been employed by Commonwealth Edison in Dixon and then later as a shift forman at the Bryon Nuclear Station until retirement in 1982. He was a Veteran of the Army Air Corps during WW II.
