May 29, 1918 - January 10, 2011

Eileen "Susie" Hahn, age 92, of Dixon, passed away January 10, 2011 in her home following a long illness. She was born May 29, 1918 in Sheffield, Illinois the daughter of Herman and Helena (Jorgensen) Knudsen. She was baptized and confirmed in St. Peter's Danish Evangelical Lutheran Church of Sheffield, which was established in 1869, and is now listed in the National Historic Register as the first of its kind in the U.S. She was a long time employee of Venier's Jewelers and worked for three generations of the Venier family. She married Russell J. Hahn of Dixon. He preceded her in death in 1972. She was also preceded in death by her parents and two brothers Norbert and Bernard Knudsen. She is survived by her sisters Norma M. Kellen and Beverly Pitzer, both of Dixon; brother Roland (Dorothy) Knudsen of Harmon; sister-in-law Betty Knudsen of Dixon. Visitation will be held on Wednesday, January 12, 2011, from 2:00 until 6:00 PM in the Jones Funeral Home in Dixon. Private family graveside services will be held on Thursday at Chapel Hill Memorial Gardens in Dixon. Memorials have been established to KSB Hospice in Dixon and Granny Rose Animal Shelter.
