Ellwyn J. "Al" Vaessen 80 of Polo died Friday February 27, 2009 in his home. He was born on August 7, 1928 in Sublette, IL the son of Frank and Blanche (Rubel) Vaessen. He had been employed as a construction foreman by Commonwealth Edison Co. for 38 years prior to his retirement on August 7, 1988. He was a veteran of the United State Army Air Corp. serving from 1946 until 1949. During the Berlin Airlift he flew 146 missions in to Berlin. He was a member of St. Mary's Catholic Church in Polo, The Polo VFW Post, member of and Past Commander of the Polo American Legion Patrick Fagan Post. 83. a member of the Polo Knights of Columbus Council, a charter member and past board member of the Edgewood Golf Course and a member of the Dixon Elks Lodge 779.
