Elmer E. Shaw Sr., age 90 of Dixon and formerly Amboy, died Saturday September 29, 2007 at the Lee County Nursing and Rehab Center in Dixon. He was a life long farmer in the Shaw Station area. He was born in Lee Center Twp. Lee County Illinois on Dec. 11, 1916 the son of Sherman M. and Eva (Turner) Shaw. He married Opal Spencer on June 15, 1940 in Clinton, IA.
