



## Elnor Nelson

October 26, 1916 - January 29, 2012

Elnor Gertrude Nelson (Olson), age 95, of Dixon, IL (formerly of St. Cloud, MN) died Sunday, Jan. 29. She was born Oct. 26, 1916 to Elmer and Gornelia Olson (Peterson) in rural Webster County, Iowa. She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband of 71 years, Rev. Clifford H. Nelson, her granddaughter, Ingrid Nelson, and two older sisters, Willetta O'Brion and Jodella Legvold. Elnor is survived by four children: David Nelson (Claudia) of Grand Detour, IL, Naomi Nelson (Philip Dahlberg) of Houston, TX, Eldon Nelson of Canyon Lake, TX; and Stephen Nelson (Maureen) of Park Ridge, IL. She will be remembered for her devoted love of her family and friends, her keen sense of fun and humor, her interest in Norwegian traditions, and her talents for folk painting, baking, entertaining, public speaking and writing. Elnor was the epitome of a faithful family member and friend who was treasured for her tender relationships with others, her warm hospitality, and

her grateful spirit. Her death is a significant loss for all who knew and loved her. Funeral service and burial will be held at St. Olaf Lutheran Church, rural Belmond, IA on Sat., Feb 4 at 1:30 p.m. Visitation will precede the service at 12:00 P.M.
