June 21, 1942 - March 1, 2021

Eugene "Gene" A. Leffelman age 78 of Sublette IL died on Monday March 1, 2021 at his home, with his sons by his side, following a short illness. He was born on June 21, 1942 in Sublette IL the son of Charles and Mildred (Kuebel) Leffelman. Gene was a life long farmer and mechanic at the VO Bonnell and Sons in Sublette IL. He was a devoted member of the Our Lady of Perpetual Help Catholic Church in Sublette, a 20 year member at the Sublette Fire Dept., and a 20 year director of the Sublette Farmers Elevator Board. 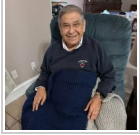
