Evelyn McNinch, age 94 of Lee Center, died Tuesday September 30, 2008 at the Amboy Rehabilitation and Nursing Center. She was born in Borton, Illinois May 12, 1914 the daughter of Rev. Wesley L. and Sally (Bowers) Blackwell. She had owned and operated with her husband McNinch Grocery in Lee Center. She worked in the office of the Lee County Grain Association and Lee Center School District 271. She then worked for Klines Department Store and Osco Drug Store in Dixon. She had also worked for Dr. Charles LaSage and Airtite Corp. in Dixon prior to her retirement in 1979. She was a member of the Lee Center Congregational United Church of Christ; she was active in many civic organizations and enjoyed playing piano and organ as well as spending time with her family and friends. She was united in marriage to Earl McNinch in Oakwood, Illinois November 12, 1933. He preceded her in death November 5, 1964. She was also preceded in death by her daughter Earlene "Punky" McNinch; 1 great grandson, brothers Stewart, John, Herbert, Paul "Pete", Merle "Bill", Charles "Joe" and Bob Blackwell and a sister Ellen Curtis.
