MAYTOWN – Evelyn G. Ryan, 81, of Maytown, died Tuesday, Jan. 13, 2009 in Mendota Community Hospital. Services were Saturday in Our Lady of Perpetual Help Church, Sublette, with the Rev. Edward Hughes officiating. Burial was Monday in St. Patrick’s Cemetery, Maytown. Visitation was Saturday, prior to the services, in the church. The Mihm-Jones Funeral Home, Amboy, handled the arrangements. Mrs. Ryan was born March 31, 1927 in May Township, Lee County, to Cornelius and Gertrude (Battin) Garland. She married John W.
