



## Florence Daehler

March 1, 1915 - January 28, 2012

Florence W. Daehler, age 96, of Mendota, and formerly of Dixon, died Saturday, January 28, 2012 at Heritage Health in Mendota. She was born March 1, 1915, in Sublette, the daughter of Henry and Sadie (Schamberger) Roemmich. She had worked for H.D. Conkey in Mendota prior to her job at Freeman Shoe Co. in Dixon for many years until the factory closed. Florence was a member of the First Presbyterian Church in Dixon; the Lee County Council on Aging, and AARP. She married Robert Daehler at St. Paul Evangelical and Reformed Church in Bureau County September 13, 1958. He preceded her in death January 12, 1969. She was also preceded in death by her parents; 1 sister Esther Zimmerlein; 1 brother Wilson Roemmich; nephew Kenneth Zimmerlein; niece Nancy Williams. Survivors include 1 brother Ralph Roemmich of Mendota; 2 sisters Gertrude Fitzgerald of Mandota, and Lillian (Melvin) Monson of Rockford; several nieces and nephews and great nieces and nephews. Cremation rites have been accorded. Memorial services will be held on Friday, February 3, 2012, at 1:30 PM in the First Presbyterian Church in Dixon with the Rev. , officiating. Burial of cremains will follow in Chapel Hill Memorial Gardens in Dixon. Visitation will be held on Friday, from 12:30 PM until time of service in the church. In lieu of flowers, memorials have been established to Kreider Services in Dixon and Heritage Health in Mendota.
