Floyd "Ken" Fox age 92 of Dixon died Sunday March 17, 2013 at Liberty Court Assisted Care Living Facility. He was born Dec. 26, 1920 in Dixon the son of Floyd and Marie (Curran) Fox. He had worked for Commonwealth Edison for 35 years prior to his retirement in 1981.

He was a veteran of the Army during WW II. He was a member of the American Legion, St Patrick Catholic Church where he was an usher for 20 years and Ken was an Avid Notre Dame fan.

He married Hazel F Byers Jan. 6, 1943 in Waco, TX. She preceded him in death March 11, 2010.
