Forrest O. "Bud" Robinson age 87 of Dixon, IL died Monday Aug. 4, 2008 at Amboy Rehab. and Nursing Center. He was born August 24, 1920 in Kewanee, Il the son of Clarence and Minnie (Mannon) Robinson. He had been employed by Shaw Publishing in Dixon as a pressman for over 35 years prior to his retirement in 1985. He served in the United States Marine Corps during World War II.
