April 9, 1921 - May 13, 2007

Frances L Glaser age 86 of Dixon died Sat. May 12, 2007 at the Israel Family Hospice in Ames, IA. She was born April 9, 1921 in Rochelle, IL the daughter of Earl and Ella (Mihm) Kennedy.
