Frances M Trompeter, age 90, formerly of Ashton, passed away on Wed. Dec. 22, 2010 at the Liberty Court Assisted Living facility in Dixon. Fran, as she was known, was born Feb. 1, 1920, in Marseilles, IL, the daughter of Peter and Grace (Brodbeck) Mitchell. She married Edward A Trompeter on Dec. 2, 1939, in Seneca, IL. They moved to the Ashton area in 1941 where they farmed and raised their family. For a number of years, Fran drove a bus for the school district. In 1985, they retired and moved to Dixon.
