Frank E. Muhleback, age 92, of Dixon, died Sunday June 4, 2017, at Dixon Healthcare Center. He was born December 3, 1924, in Dixon, the son of Frank and Rachel (Bush) Muhleback.

He was a Veteran of the Navy during World War II.

Frank worked for Dixon Home Phone Co through Sprint for 32 years prior to his retirement in 1990.

Frank was a member of St. Anne Catholic Church in Dixon where he had served on the Building Commission, a member of the Dixon American Legion Post 12, the Independent Telephone Employees Association, the Lee County Housing Authority. He was also Past President of the Wally Byam Airstream Caravan Club.
