



Gary L. Mallo

November 18, 1935 - January 13, 2023

Beloved Dr. Gary L. Mallo, age 87, of Grand Detour and formerly of St. Charles, died Friday Jan 13, 2023 at his home. He was born Nov. 18, 1935 in Webster City, IA, the son of Elmer and Bernice (Campbell) Mallo. Gary did his undergraduate studies at Iowa State University and continued on to receive his DVM from Iowa State College of Veterinary Medicine in 1960. He first worked at the Riser Animal Hospital in Skokie, IL. before returning to Iowa State to earn his Masters and teach at the Veterinary School. There he was voted "Distinguished Teacher of the Year" by his students at the age of 28. Gary went on to own and operate the Geneva Animal Hospital, and then St. Charles Veterinary Clinic for a total of 26 years, prior to retirement. Gary married Penny Petersen Nov. 18, 1965 in Ames, IA and is survived by his wife Penny, Children Michael Mallo of Denver, CO, Jane (Clint) Jungerman of Dixon, Paul Mallo of Island Lake, IL, Kathryn (David) Kiker of Apex, NC, 8 grandchildren Sara (Jon) Forbes, Clay, Sam, Luke, Ana and George Jungerman, Owen and Magie Kiker, and 2 great granddaughters Charlotte and Ivy Forbes. He is preceded in death by his parents and one sister, Mary Sue Segar. He was a member of St. Patrick Church in Dixon. He volunteered with the Loaves and Fishes program, enjoyed delivering Meals on Wheels, and was a Pro Life advocate. While raising their own children, Gary and Penny also cared for over 30 foster children during their years in St. Charles. To know him was to love him. Gary will lovingly be remembered for his devotion to God and family, priceless sense of humor, and genuine

compassion for both humans and animals. Mass of Christian Burial will be on Friday Jan 20, 2023 at 11:00 AM at St Patrick Catholic Church in Dixon with Msgr. Daniel Hermes celebrating. Burial will follow at Grand Detour Cemetery. Visitation will be on Thursday Jan. 19, 2023 from 4:00 to 7:00 PM at the Jones Funeral Home in Dixon with the Rosary at 6:45 PM. A memorial has been established with Serenity Hospice and Gianna's House Pregnancy Resource Center.
