Georgia L Ryan age 76 of Casa Grande, AZ and formerly of Dixon and Peru, IL died Thursday April 3, 2014 in her home. She was born February 7, 1938 in Dixon the daughter of William Herbert and Georgia (Pruett) Mayes. She had worked at the Dixon Home Phone Company, KSB Hospital and had been a dog groomer for many years. She had also done volunteer work at Sun West, with talking books.

Georgia was also the first women elected to the Peru, IL city council.

She was a member of the Red Hat Society.

She married Michael Ryan in Dixon in November of 1969.
