Harold E Cavanaugh age 81 of Chandler, AZ and formerly of Polo, IL and Dixon, IL died Friday Sept. 21, 2007 in Chandler, AZ He was born Jan. 12, 1926 in Dixon, IL the son of Henry and Kathryn (Vaile) Cavanaugh. Harold grew up on a farm outside of Polo, IL known as "Cavanaugh's Corner". He was a United States Army Veteran serving in the European-African-Middle Eastern theater during WW II. He was the recipient of the Victory Medal, two Bronze Battle Stars, two Overseas Service Bars, Army of Occupation (Germany), and Good Conduct Medal. Following the War he was employed by Commonwealth Edison until his retirement and subsequent move to Arizona. He had also farmed in the Polo area.

He was a lifetime member of the Casa Grande VFW Post 1677, He had also been a member of the Dixon VFW Post 540, Dixon American Legion Post 12 and the Dixon Elks Lodge 779.

He was married to Mary Ann "Midge" Jenkins in St. Patrick Catholic church Dixon in November of 1949. She preceded him in death in April 1962 He was also preceded in death by a daughter Ann Marie, brothers William Cavanaugh and Paul Cavanaugh and a sister Helen Cavanaugh Burke.
