Helen M. Doyle, age 89, of Rockford and formerly of Dixon, died Monday, December 13, 2010 at the Provena St. Anne Center in Rockford. She was born in Walton, Illinois, February 15, 1921, the daughter of Joseph M. and Frances (Harvey) O'Malley. She had worked for Lawrence Brothers in Sterling, and at the Green River Ordinance Plant in Amboy. She was also a real estate broker, owning the Doyle real Estate Agency in Dixon for many years. She was also a teacher's aide for the 4th grade at St. Mary School in Dixon. She is a past member of St. Patrick Catholic Church in Dixon where she served as past president of the Altar and Rosary Society. She was a member of Holy Family Catholic Church in Rockford from 1972 until the present. She entered the United States Navy during World War II, serving in Oklahoma and the Great Lakes region. She married Charles F. Doyle October 9, 1944 at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Sterling. He preceded her in death on August 21, 2006. She was also preceded in death by a sister Mary Stayton Burke. Helen is survived by 2 daughters Maureen Nichols of Dixon, and Mary (Michael Scheurich) Doyle of Rockford; 1 son Terry (Sally) Doyle of Sussex, WI; 5 grandchildren; 5 great grandchildren; 1 sister Frances (John A.) McGinn of Peoria; 1 brother John J. (Nancy) O'Malley of Huntley; many nieces and nephews. Mass of Christian Burial will be held on Friday December 17, 2010 at 11:00 AM at Holy Family Catholic Church in Rockford with the Rev. Msgr. David D. Kagan, Pastor, and Fr.
