Henry W. "Hank" Wohrley, age 85, of Dixon, died Sunday, Sept. 4, 2016, at KSB Hospital in Dixon. He was born April 17, 1931, in Dixon, the son of Andrew and Marie (Arion) Wohrley. He had owned and operated Wohrley Heating and Air Conditioning from 1965 until his retirement.
