August 1, 1923 - December 14, 2018

Ann Williams, age 95, of Macomb, and formerly of Dixon, died Friday, December 14, 2018, at Wesley Village Healthcare Center in Macomb. She was born August 1, 1923, in Belvidere, the daughter of Joseph and Josephine (Corrall) Dominguez.

She had been a Secretary for the Masonic Temple in Dixon and also the Lee County Highway Department prior to her retirement.

Ann was a longtime member of St. Anne Catholic Church in Dixon.

She married William C. Williams in Freeport, September 18, 1948. He preceded her in death May 4, 1979. She was also preceded in death by her daughter Melissa Inman, and a grandson Nicholas Inman.
