May 6, 1923 - September 19, 2007

Howard L. Hageman age 84 of Amboy, died Wednesday September 19, 2007 in the Amboy Rehabilitation and Nursing Center . He was born in West Brooklyn, IL on May 6, 1923 the son of Charles and Lena (Braunmeier) Hageman.

He had owned and operated Hageman Heating and Cooling in Amboy from 1965 to his retirement in 1985. He had served in the United States Army during World War II.
