July 1, 1942 - February 18, 2016

James L. "Lobo" Reubin, age 73, of Dixon, died unexpectedly Thursday, February 18, 2016, at KSB Hospital in Dixon.

He was born July 1, 1942, in Dixon, the son of Herman and Pauline (Wagner) Reubin Sr.

Jim was a Jet Engine Technician (TSgt) for the United States Air Force for 20 years. He owned and operated Jim's Pit Stop in Dixon for 13 years, and was a Tool and Die maker at Allied Locke Industries in Amboy until his retirement.

He was Commissioner of the Veterans Memorial Park in Dixon and instrumental in bringing the F105 Thunderchief Jet to the park.

He was a member of the Amboy American Legion and the NRA.

Jim married Rosemarie McMichael in Dixon in November of 1986. She preceded him in death in September of 2009.

Jim was also preceded in death by his parents; 1 brother Herman Reubin, Jr.; 1 sister Evelyn "Effie" Sensenig; 1 granddaughter Brittany Reubin.

Survivors include 5 daughters Michelle (Frank) Gecan of Oregon, Tracy (Ed) Mayo of Duxbury, MA, Kristi (Steve) Gedville of Lindenhurst, Deanna Comstock and Ginger Reubin both of Iowa; 7 grandchildren Brandon, Ashley, Courtney, Allison, Madison, Alyssa, Brianna; 2 great-granddaughters Kennidy and Keira; 4 brothers Ronald and Donald of Texas, John of California, and David of Dixon; 2 sisters Carol of Colorado and Kathryn of Belleville.

Cremation rites have been accorded. Memorial services will be held Saturday April 23, 2016 at 1:00 PM at Veteran Memorial Park in Dixon. In case of rain
