September 28, 1919 - August 25, 2010

Jeannette A. Zurliene, age 90 of Amboy, died Wednesday August 25, 2010 in Mendota Community Hospital. She was born September 28, 1919 in Sublette, the daughter of William and Jessie (Fischer) Dulen. She had been a teacher for 7 years in one room school houses in May Township. She was united in marriage to Urban W. Zurliene in Maytown May 17, 1947. He preceded her in death Sept. 29, 1974. She was also preceded in death by a grandchild Kendra McCracken and 2 sisters Bernice Scheidenhelm and Margery Broers. She was a member of St. Patrick Catholic Church in Amboy, the Catholic Womens Club, the Amboy American Legion Auxiliary for 55 years, and the Amboy Hobby Club.
