



## Jeffry Scott Smith

December 10, 1946 - March 4, 2018

Jeffry S. Smith, age 71, of Dixon, was ushered into heaven Sunday March 4, 2018. He was born December 10, 1946, in Dixon, the son of Scott and Fredda (Walker) Smith. He had worked for Hal Roberts Company for 20 years and then worked in the building and grounds department at Sauk Valley Community College for 12 years prior to his retirement.

Jeffry was a Veteran of the Army, and a member of the American Legion.
