John W. Clayton, age 48, of Mahomet, IL, died suddenly, August 15, 2016, at Carle Foundation Hospital in Urbana, IL. He was born August 25, 1967, in Amboy, IL, to Donald J. and Clara M. (Forristall) Clayton.

John was a graduate of Amboy High School in 1985. He completed his degree at Morrison Institute of Technology in 1987. During and following his college education he worked as a Draftsman for V&C Construction and Production Engineered Products in Walnut, IL. He then worked for Eagle Foods in Milan, IL, before becoming Senior Project Manager for SuperValu/Save-A-Lot Foods in 1998.

John was an avid hunter and took an annual hunting trip with several friends. He loved spending time with his children and enjoyed coaching them in baseball and softball. He loved Notre Dame, Steelers football, and all things John Wayne. He was a member of Our Lady of the Lake Catholic Church in Mahomet, IL, and Friends of the NRA.

John married Angela Pitzer at St. Patrick Catholic Church in Amboy June 20, 1987.

His father, Donald J. Clayton and brother, Justin Clayton, preceded him in death. Survivors include his wife; daughter Morgan Clayton and son Daniel Clayton, both of Mahomet; his mother, Clara Clayton of Amboy; three brothers Don (Sheila) Clayton and Scott (Debbie) Clayton, both of Amboy; Troy (Denise) Clayton of Minooka; and several nieces, nephews, and great-nieces and nephews.
