



Joseph Vincent Lendman

May 6, 1928 - July 16, 2017

Joseph V. Lendman, age 89, of Dixon, died Sunday, July 16, 2017, at Pinecrest Manor in Mount Morris following a short illness. He was born May 6, 1928, in Sterling, the son of Charles J. and Mary Catherine (Gaffey) Lendman. He was a Printer for the Sterling Gazette and then the Dixon Telegraph for 46 years prior to his retirement in 1993.

Joe was a Veteran of the Marine Corps.

He was a member of St. Anne Catholic Church in Dixon and the Dixon Knights of Columbus Council 690.

He married Patricia Saunders June 21, 1951 at St Mary Catholic Church in Sterling. She preceded him in death December 20, 2016.
