July 15, 1938 - February 4, 2013

Joyce A. Anderson, age 74, of Dixon, died Monday February 4, 2013 at OSF St. Anthony Medical Center in Rockford following a short illness.

She was born July 15, 1938, in West Brooklyn, the daughter of James and Gertrude (Goy) Kelly. She was a graduate of Dixon High School and was the Homecoming Queen in the Fall of 1955.

Joyce had worked for Kline's Dept. Store, Gamet Liquors, the Trailside and Stables. She was a member of St. Patrick Catholic Church in Dixon; a past volunteer for KSB Hospital; she was also a longtime volunteer with Northwest Illinois Special Olympics for bowling, spring games, and the Pumpkin Pedal. She had also served on the committee for the Kick Off the Holiday fundraiser. She married Richard E. "Dick" Anderson in Dixon, November 9, 1957. He preceded her in death January 13, 2001.

Joyce was also preceded in death by 1 grandson Lukas Kelly; 1 brother David Kelly; 1 sister Jane Baxter.
